Qualifications

- PhD completed on the starting date (candidates who have completed and submitted their dissertation may also be considered) in management (or closely related field such as organizational behavior, human resources management, social psychology, applied economics, etc.);
- Excellent research capability as evidenced by a strong publication record and/or research pipeline;
- Experimental design skills are required;
- Competence in advanced quantitative data analysis (SPSS, STATA, R, etc.);
- Interest and, ideally, some experience with crowdsourcing science, i.e. large projects involving numerous experimental manipulations or coordinating the contributions of a number of sub-teams;
- Ability to work both as part of a team and independently;
- Excellent oral and written communication in English;
- Programming skills are desirable but not required.
